Starter / Local Club Delegate Guidelines

Individual Event:

1. There is a requirement to set 3 tables marked "A", "B", "C" GRADE.
2. **The STARTERS will provide a blank card to each competitor on payment of entry fee,** (no card will be available from other locations)
3. The starters are required to print the course slope rating to be readily accessible by players near the registration area.
4. Each competitor is to fill his own card in legible writing and include:
 - Name
 - Club
 - Date
 - Daily handicap
 - Golf Link Number
5. The Starters are to write the name & handicap of players on the starting sheet and to retain cards until ready to start groups.
6. The Starters are to organise the playing groups taking into account cart sharing. Groups will be sent as directed by the starter not later than the specified starting time.
7. On completion of the round each competitor is responsible for checking his score and returning the signed card to the "Scorers" table
8. The scorer is required to place cards in order of results in the respective A, B or C grades
9. The results will be promptly available for the Captain for all 3 grades to ensure presentation can be undertaken within 10 minutes of the last card being handed in.
10. Starter / Delegate is responsible to ensure ALL scores are entered into GOLFLINK ASAP after the completion of the event.

4BBB & Ambrose Event:

1. Only one grade will be run for 4BBB & Ambrose events and the number of trophies will be proportional to the number of players.
2. The starters are required to print the course slope rating to be readily accessible by players near the registration area.
3. **The STARTERS will provide ONE blank card to each pair on payment of both entry fees,** (no card will be available from other locations)
4. If competitor already has a PARTNER, both are required to fill the card in a legible writing and include:
 - Names of both competitors
 - Clubs
 - Date
 - Daily handicaps
 - Golf Link Numbers
 - Completed card to be returned to starter / registration table
5. If a competitor does not have a PARTNER, he is required to fill the card in a legible writing and include:
 - Name
 - Club
 - Date

- Daily handicap
- Golf Link Numbers
- Completed card to be returned to starter / registration table for allocation of partner
- Once a partner is allocated, the card is completed by both partners, ensuring all details are correct. **The filling of the card REMAINS the responsibility of the PLAYERS.**

6. The Starters are to write the names & handicaps of players on the starting sheet and **ensure to collect the money from BOTH PLAYERS.**
7. The Starters are to organise the playing groups taking into account cart sharing. Groups will be sent as directed by the starter not later than the specified starting time.
8. On completion of the round competitors are responsible for checking score and returning the signed card to the "Scorers" table
9. The scorer is required to place cards in order of results, ensuring scores and all details (signatures & handicaps) on the card are correct.
10. The results will be readily available for the Captain in a prompt manner to ensure presentation can be undertaken within 10 minutes of the last card being handed in.

Note:

If a card is not completed correctly (handicap, signatures or golf link number) as per the rules of golf, the competitor(s) will be disqualified.
