6- General Business

Sponsorship

2 Major sponsorships have been agreed for 2021 including:

Membership and Competition Fees for 2021

The Membership fee and competition fee will remain as follows:

Peter bray requested feedback on the issues and errors found in the VVGA Parmaker booklet. The feedback came back from Richard Olsen (VVGA President) who is committed in addressing the ongoing issues with the Parmaker Booklet.

Shotgun start: The idea has been welcomed by most but some clubs like the flexibility of being able to run a ROLLING START 08:30 to 09:30. The SHOTGUN START will be our default procedure with the proviso that Club Delegates will determine if a ROLLING START is more applicable to his / her club.

John Wilson congratulated Yallourn GC for the great organisation in running today's event. It sets a benchmark for running successful WGVGA events.
