6- General Business

<u>Sponsorship</u>

4 Major sponsorships have been agreed for 2023 including:

- 1- Latrobe Valley Village has agreed to sponsoring 3 events (Yallourn Moe & Trafalgar) to the value of \$400 each and also to have an aggregate trophy for the 3 events to the value of \$300 (\$200 winner & \$100 R-UP).
- 2- Latrobe Valley Funeral Services will sponsor 3 events to the value of \$400 each(\$1200 total); thank you to Peter Bray for his great work in obtaining this and Traralgon GC sponsorships to the value of \$750 for the 2 events to be hosted by Traralgon GC
- 3- Drummonds Traralgon has agreed to sponsor 2 events to the value of \$400 each
- 4- Traralgon GC will sponsor the 2 events scheduled for Traralgon

Membership and Competition Fees for 2023

The Membership fee and competition fee will remain as follows:

Membership fee \$15.00 and \$10 for members joining after June 2023.

Competition fee \$25.00 except for the Christmas event which shall be \$30.00 and 100% of the fee will go to the host club of the event.

The issue of some clubs asking for a higher fee was raised and the Secretary will negotiate with clubs and endeavour to maintain the prices as low as possible.

As no changes to the present cost the proposal was not voted by the members.

2023 Schedule- will have a winter break as per the 2022 scheduled as this is viewed as a positive move. West Gippsland players have attended events in the South Gippsland District during the winter break.

The pocket calendar has not been ordered as this saves \$320 and its value is questionable as all the information is available on our website.

The cost of cart hire by some clubs is seen by some VETS as excessively high but it's outside the control of the WGVGA Committee. The Secretary to discuss with clubs to see if a better deal can be arranged for our members.

President's Report 2022

This past year has been a great success compared to the previous few years with COVID restrictions. Whilst COVID is still with us and quite a concern, at least we have been able to get on with our games at our member courses and with good attendances. Our revised programme with a winter break has meant fewer cancellations due to weather despite above average rainfall.

Utilising shotgun starts has meant that more players remain for presentation than has happened in the past. Unfortunately, that those who don't like an early start, particularly when travelling for more than hour beforehand, have chosen to miss a number of events. It also means long queues for meals that would otherwise be spread over a longer period and the score processing cannot be started until the field have completed the event. Club delegates have been asked for member feedback on starting times. Let's hope we get some positive suggestions. I should mention that Australian Veterans start all their events at midday. On a personal note, I am due for a hip replacement in the new year and will be out of golf for some months. So, I'm vacating the president's chair.

Thank you to all the committee for their support, particularly our captain David Rash who has done an excellent job in managing the competitions and our secretary Bill Estrada who continues to organise our entire operation. We could not continue to have such smoothly run events without all the committee and club delegates.

The running of the scheduled events during 2022 has proceeding as per schedule with the exception of the Traralgon event in September and the Drouin & Deep Creek events due to heavy rains affecting course condition.

The implementation of the winter break has served our district well as 2022 has been a very wet year and many of the winter events would have been affected by course unavailability during winter.

Some of our players attended SOUTH GIPPSLAND EVENTS during winter and they were very happy to have some of our players as numbers are generally low for winter events.
